Smartness / Revised School Uniform Policy

There are some children who have returned to school wearing blue polo shirts. These are no longer school uniform and white polo shirts must be worn. (Pale blue polo shirts can still be worn in P.E.) Please ensure that your child wears the correct uniform and has their PE kit in school every day. Thank you for your support here.

School Dinners

We politely remind you that school dinners must be paid for in advance. If funds are not received, parents will be contacted and expected to provide a packed lunch instead. Next week, we will be on Week 2 of our menu. School dinners cost £2.30 per day (KS2).

Cash Payments

To help us as much as possible, please make sure cash payments are put in a named envelope and state the reason for the payment. Separate payments for each purpose would also be of great assistance. If payment is made online, permission slips still need to be returned to the school. Your help is much appreciated.

Late Attendance

Please make every effort to make sure your child arrives in class on time. There are many children who are continually late and this impacts on their learning and it also has a detrimental effect on the class. School starts at 8.50 am and children should be ready to work then. Please therefore allow sufficient time for your child to remove their coat, empty their book bag etc.

Free School Meals

Just a reminder that if you think you may be eligible, the school has a letter that explains eligibility and how to apply. This may be particularly relevant for Year 3 pupils as in Key Stage 2, school dinners must be paid for unless you are eligible for free school meals.
